IMPORTANT: NEW rules regarding Food and Drink in the Studio

The studio is having issues with ants and roaches and we have noticed more food laying open on the floor and crumbs in all waiting areas and hallways. We would like for you to go over these expectations with your dancer please. The garbage bags are not meant for liquid and entire Starbucks and other drinks are being placed in these bags only to cause liquid to break through the bag and spill all over the floor and in the trash can when it is removed at night. We are hoping that our dance families take pride in our studio and help us out by working with us to keep food in the studio to a minimum. We know that students that are at dance for several hours need to eat, we just want to ask that they clean up after themselves by using the hand broom and dustpan after having food.

*Water is the only drink allowed in the studio by the students. (No Starbucks, Smoothies, Soda, Gatorade or Milk-Water Only Please) *No liquid is to be thrown in the trash (empty water bottles only) *Clean up your own mess after eating by disposing of wrappers and sweeping up crumbs

*When possible, eat out on the porch of the studio with a parent before entering the studio.

*Students 11 and up can obtain permission from Miss Susan, the office manager to eat on the porch when it is daylight.

*Bring food trash to one of the two hallway trash cans and do not dispose of food in the dance rooms.

*Any water spills should be cleaned up with paper towels as it is a slip hazard.

*Help us by checking around and keeping the studio tidy. Let us know of any problems.

 - *You will receive instructions on bows, headpieces or anything that needs explaining.
